Roles and responsibilities	Describe the nature of the sector of industry and their role and responsibilities as a plant operator
Preparing for work	Name and explain the purpose of principal components, the basic construction, controls and terminology
	 Conform with manufacturer's requirements as per the operator's handbook, other types of information source and relevant regulations and legislation
	Undertake all pre-use checks
Travelling and manoeuvring	Configure and set for site and highway travel
	Travel over rough, undulating ground, substantial inclines and level surfaces; laden and unladen
	Manoeuvre in confined spaces
Setting up for work	Configure and set for extraction and loading duties
	Explain actions required for hazards, underground and overhead services
Working tasks	Extract differing types of materials from stockpiles and other sources
	Form stockpiles of segregated materials and construct (temporary) ramps
	Sort and place materials into transporting vehicles and hoppers
	Spread and level ground and materials
Shutting down	Carry out shut down and securing procedures
	Explain the loading and unloading procedures for machine transporting
